THE COUNTY COURT OF WASCO COUNTY, OREGON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AUTHORITY. It is the intent of the Wasco County
Court to create an intergovernmental entity by Intergovernmental
Agreement, pursuant to ORS 190.003 through 190.110, and to ratify the
Intergovernmental Agreement signed by the COUNTIES OF GILLIAM, HOOD
RIVER, SHERMAN, WASCO and WHEELER.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of the
Intergovernmental Agreement shall be the first day of July, 1992.

Section 3. PURPOSE. The purpose of the Intergovernmental
Agreement is as follows:

a. To provide a forum for elected officials of member
governments to identify issues and needs which are regional in
scope; achieve concurrence for cooperative actions; and plan,
approve and recommend governmental actions in areas of
intergovernmental concern.

b. To attain the maximum degree of intergovernmental
cooperation possible in the five (5) County region in order to
foresee and prevent problems created by population, social,
economic and natural resource growth and change in the region.

1 c. To assure, through coordination, cooperation and
2 the pooling of common resources, maximum efficiency and economy
3 in governmental operations, which will provide every citizen of
4 the region with the utmost value for every tax dollar.

5 d. To encourage and provide the mechanism for local
6 government to plan, program and implement actions which are
7 desired for the social and economic benefit of the region's
8 citizens.

9 e. To utilize the various tools of intergovernmental
10 cooperation, such as joint enterprises, mutual aid, parallel
11 action, and contractual services on a voluntary basis through
12 formal and informal agreements.

13 Section 4. POWERS. The MID-COLUMBIA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
14 shall have the power:

15 a. To acquire funds.

16 b. To administer programs and grants.

17 c. To contract for services.

18 d. Any other such power necessary to carry out the purpose
19 of the Council.


20 Section 5. EMERGENCY. This Ordinance being necessary for the
21 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an
22 emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect
23 on July 1, 1992.




