## Inventory of Aerial Photographs April 6, 2008

*2006 GOAL: Create a centralized library of Wasco County aerial photographs.*  
Previously, old photos had been stored (but not accessibly) at the library, the Farm Services Office, and other locations. The plan is, once photos are no longer actively used by an agency, to store them upstairs at the Wasco County Public Works Building where they can be available, by appointment, to the public.

### *Progress to Date:*

Hardcopies of the following known flights have been grouped by date of flight. Most have been indexed geographically. As time allows, We've cleared the storage space, and collected the photos from various places. Presently, I'm assembling the flat file cabinets for further storage.
