### Surveyor Fund Sources

- Wasco County Surveyor Office receives \$50 per survey filed, paid directly to this office:

**209.260 Fee for filing and indexing maps or reports of surveys.** The county governing body, by resolution or order, may establish the fee to be collected by the county surveyor for filing and indexing a map or report of a survey. [1981 c.429 §2; 1985 c.582 §9; 1991 c.339 §4; 1991 c.621 §2]

- Transfer from Land Corner Preservation Fund
- Printing \$0.30 per square foot, \$1.00 minimum (per Ordinance filed 6/24/3)
- **Reviewing partition plats** \$200, collected by W.C. Planning (for non-city plats) or at recording by W.C. Clerk (for all cities: TD, Mosier, Maupin, etc.)
- **Reviewing subdivision plats** \$350 plus \$25 per lot, collected by W.C. Planning (for non-city plats) or at recording by W.C. Clerk (for all cities: TD, Mosier, Maupin, etc.)
- **Reviewing condominium plats** \$350 plus \$25 per building (change this to unit), collected by W.C. Planning (for non-city plats) or at recording by W.C. Clerk (for all cities: TD, Mosier, Maupin, etc.)
- **Property line adjustments** handled as surveys pay a \$50 survey filing fee to this office and, perhaps, a DOR cartography fee to the Assessor. This needs clarification.
- Per ORS 271.230(2), marking the record upon the original plat (has now changed), \$15 collected by the clerk and paid to the surveyor.

### Land Corner Preservation Fund Sources

- Wasco County Clerk's Office receives \$10 for each recorded instrument conveying an interest in real property, \$8 to the Public Land Corner Preservation Fund, and \$2 to the general fund.
